Pollinator garden	<ul> <li>□ Area is labeled.</li> <li>□ Plants are labeled.</li> <li>□ Plants are healthy, abundant, and accessible to students.</li> <li>□ Plants are being adequately watered.</li> <li>□ Necessary pruning is being done.</li> <li>□ Clear differentiation between walkway and beds.</li> <li>□ Garden is weeded and mulch is covering exposed soil.</li> </ul>
Shed	<ul> <li>Structure is in good condition- no water is entering and doors close properly.</li> <li>Shed has a functioning lock.</li> <li>Tools and materials are organized, clean, and properly stored.</li> </ul>
Signage	<ul> <li>Each garden area has an age-appropriate sign.</li> <li>Signs are solidly displayed, and in good shape.</li> <li>Entrance has a sign.</li> </ul>
Paths	<ul><li>Paths are clearly established, mulched, and free of weeds.</li><li>Paths are flat and connect appropriate garden elements.</li></ul>

Trees	<ul> <li>Trees are labeled.</li> <li>Trees are appropriately pruned.</li> <li>Trees are weeded, and no vines are growing up the trunks.</li> <li>Mulch surrounds base of trees.</li> <li>Trees are receiving 5 gallons of water/wk.</li> <li>Any diseases are being monitored and treated.</li> <li>Fruit, when necessary, is covered with bird netting until ready to harvest.</li> </ul>
Perennial berries	<ul> <li>Area is labeled.</li> <li>Plants are labeled.</li> <li>Plants are healthy, abundant, and accessible to students.</li> <li>Plants are being adequately watered.</li> <li>Clear differentiation between walkway and beds.</li> <li>Garden is weeded and mulch is covering exposed soil.</li> <li>Canes are being properly pruned.</li> </ul>
Outdoor classroom	<ul> <li>Seating is clean, stable, and painted.</li> <li>Chalkboard is clean, stable, and in good shape.</li> <li>Chalk and eraser are properly stored.</li> </ul>
Compost area	<ul> <li>Area is labeled.</li> <li>Maintenance plan exists.</li> <li>Decomposing pile is regularly flipped.</li> <li>Piles are being watered to maintain moisture level of wrung-out sponge.</li> <li>There is space for garden waste, and plant pieces are 6" or shorter.</li> <li>Area around compost bins is clear of trash and debris.</li> <li>Any rodent infestation is noted and an action plan is being followed.</li> </ul>
Seating area	<ul> <li>□ Benches are stable.</li> <li>□ Paint looks fresh and even.</li> <li>□ Area receives adequate shade.</li> <li>□ Area is easy to access.</li> </ul>
Entrance/ fence	<ul> <li>Entrance is clearly marked and inviting.</li> <li>Gate can be open and closed as desired.</li> <li>Gate can be locked if desired, and lock is functional.</li> <li>Weeds are removed from fences.</li> </ul>
Water/ irrigation	<ul> <li>□ Water source is accessible.</li> <li>□ Hose is in good shape with functioning nozzle.</li> <li>□ Hose is neatly stored when not in use.</li> <li>□ Key, if needed, is accessible.</li> </ul>
Grounds	<ul> <li>All trash is picked up and disposed of.</li> <li>Weeds and other garden materials are removed and properly stored.</li> <li>All areas of garden are safe and tidy.</li> <li>Grass is cut.</li> </ul>
